**ORDINANCE #234**

**REVISION OF ORDINANCE #A-220 REGULATING  
REMOVAL AND IMPOUNDMENT OF ILLEGALLY PARKED  
VEHICLES**

An Ordinance of the Township of Pulaski, Beaver County, Pennsylvania amending, in part, Ordinance Number A-220 (the same being codified in the Pulaski Township Code of Ordinances as Section 15-501 et seq) of said Township, known as an ordinance regulating the removal and impoundment of illegally parked vehicles.

The Township of Pulaski, by and through the Supervisors of the same, does hereby enact, ordain and establish the following Amendment of the aforementioned Ordinance:

I. Section 15-506 is hereby amended as follows:

In order to reclaim his/her vehicle, the owner shall pay all towing costs (provided that the Township has been billed or has knowledge that it shall be billed for said towing costs), plus a \$100.00 fee for administrative purposes before reclaiming his/her vehicle from the approved storage garage. Said owner shall be provided a receipt evidencing payment of all such towing and administrative costs and the same shall be presented to the designated storage garage before said vehicle may be released to the owner. The said administrative fee may be amended from time to time at the discretion of the Township Supervisors of Pulaski by Resolution for the same.

II. Section 15-509 is hereby amended as follows:

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Part (Ordinance) shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of up to \$300.00 together with all costs of disposing of the vehicle under the provisions of the Vehicle Code, 75 P.S.

Section 7301 et seq. as hereafter amended, supplemented, modified or reenacted by the General Assembly of Pennsylvania.

III. Section 15-511 is hereby added to said Ordinance as follows:

Pulaski Township shall, in addition to all other remedies provided herein, have the authority to maintain a civil action against any individual owner of a towed vehicle for any other costs associated with said towing and other expenses.

IV. In all other respects, Ordinance Number A-220 (Section 15-501, et seq) shall remain unchanged and in effect, and all prior Ordinances not in conformity with this Amendment are hereby rescinded to the extent that they are not in conformity with the same.
