**ORDINANCE NUMBER A-A-223**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PULASKI,  
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 209, AS AMENDED, AND AS CODIFIED  
IN SECTION 7-101 ET SEQ. OF PART 1 OF CHAPTER 7  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
PULASKI, AS ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 10, 2001, BY  
ORDINANCE NO. A220 WHICH  
REGULATED OUTDOOR BURNING.**

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED**, by the Township Supervisor of the Township of Pulaski, Beaver, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That Section 7-102 of Part 1 of Chapter 7 of Ordinance No. A220 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**§7-102. Burning Rubbish:** From and after the enactment of this Part, it shall be unlawful for any firm, person or corporation to burn any waste paper, rubbish, leaves or brush on Sunday or Monday or at any other time except as herein provided. Said burning shall be limited to the hours of 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Tuesday through Saturday inclusive during the months of January, February, March, April, May, September, October, November and December. The time herein specified shall be construed to be Eastern Standard Time when such time is in effect in the community and shall be construed to be Daylight Savings Time when such time is in effect in the community of the Township. **Burning shall be prohibited at all times during the months of June, July and August of any calendar year.**

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.**
