

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
APRIL 13, 2015**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Police Chief VanFossan, Ray Hickman, Terry Johnson, Carol and Wayne Everly, Donn Sheets, Norman Bible, Vicky Scott, Bonnie Loftus, Nellie Loftus, Tom Albanese, and Attorney Budicak.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting of March 9, 2015 and the Special Meeting of March 23, 2015. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay the bills. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for March, 2015 with a total of 36 calls was given to the supervisors. He had nothing new to report.

Fire Department: Alan Hickey turned in a report that there were three fire calls in March all in Pulaski. The report will be put on file.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Mr. Thomas Albanese was present and his report for March will be put on file. Mr. Margetic asked Mr. Albanese to please check on all the rubbish on 42nd Avenue, and 39th Street and 43rd Street (Properties of Albert Hovanick). Donn Sheets asked what is going to be done about the car without a title on 39th Street. Attorney Budicak was to do something about it months and months ago. Mr. Mooney wants something done about the property owned by the New Brighton School District that is never cut, trash everywhere. He wants it cleaned up.

Recreation Commission: Mr. McCullough was not present.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy in March, working on the equipment, fixing signs, patching pot holes, a lot of salting and snow removal. He also reported that catch basins have been purchased for 47th Street and 52nd Street. As soon as Mike can get some help with installing them, they will be done.

Terry Johnson wants to know what is going to be done about 38th Avenue and all the water in his yard. There was a lengthy discussion about the situation. The supervisors have had the personnel from PennDot there three different times now, state representatives and there is nothing the supervisors can do to correct the problem. There is no place to run the water. The township is not permitted to run runoff onto a state road. Ms. Bonnie Loftus also complained about the water at 3205 and 3207 – 47th Street. Mr. Margetic said that he would have Mike check out both places on Tuesday. The problem is when we get too much rain at one time and there is just no place for the water to go.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Attorney Budicak informed the supervisors that the insurance company wants information in writing from the township. He gave the secretary papers for Mike Zachodni to fill out for the lawyers in the case.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to exonerate Judy K. Hage of the 2014 Real Estate Taxes and 2014 Per Capita Taxes. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to turn the Delinquent Per Capita Taxes over to Berkheimer Associates for collection. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept a quote of \$400.00 from Four Seasons Lawn Service to remove shrubs that are overgrown around the Monument in the front of the Fire Department, dispose of the shrubs, install new shrubs (up to 100 Dollars) and put stone up to two ton to make it more presentable. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to advertise for the FEMA Flood Plain Ordinance. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mrs. Carol Everly wants all the catch basins in the township cleaned out.

Mr. Everly inquired about the Township recycling. The township will not be doing that.

Ms. Vicky Scott of 3816 – 46th Street is very upset with the progress of her complaint about the noise that is going on until very late at night and early mornings. She has taken all the steps that she was told to do and nothing is being done. She was told to file a complaint in the District Justice Office. Violators of the noise ordinance have to be notified three times. She has repeatedly called the police and there are still no results. Mr. Mooney said he would talk to the property owner and tell him to evict the tenant.

Bonnie Loftus, 3205 – 47th Street, expressed concern about the water problems on 47th Street. Also, her neighbor has a sump pump and she believes it is being dumped in her back yard. Attorney Budicak told her to knock on the neighbor's door and ask where the water is going. That is a neighbor problem, not a township problem.

Mr. Mooney wants the supervisors to correct the water problems on 47th Street and Mr. Albanese to check with the School District about cleaning up their property.
