

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
June 8, 2015**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Vice-Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag. Mr. Hage was absent.

In attendance were the following people: Police Chief VanFossan, Nellie Loftus, Donn Sheets, Joe Zilk, Vicky Scott, Casey Zachodni, Terry and Kim Johnson, Don Beegle, Tom Albanese, and Attorney Budicak.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 11, 2015. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, absent; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

Don Sheets asked the Chief of Police why when the police were called two months ago about a rabid raccoon and they still have not answered the call. He also stated that the Beaver County Humane Society doesn't return any calls and he is tired of his neighbor feeding all the wild cats and they are using his yard for their bathroom. There is a cat problem all over the place. There are no laws governing cats.

Joe Zilk questioned why nothing is being done about the cars with broken glass at the car lot on Rochester Road. Mr. Albanese will check into it.

Nellie Loftus said the water is too high on the street at 3205 – 3207 47th Street. Something needs done. The problem is the residents raised their front yard too high.

Vicky Scott said the house on the corner from her place is noisy and they use terrible language.

COMMITTEE REPORTS
