

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP

Everyone is worried about what will happen when winter comes and people stopping for the stop sign coming up the hill could have problems.

Bill Thomas said that there are three red vehicles on the Morgan property with no license/inspections. He wanted to know if Ross has permission to use the Morgan property. He inquired about the property across the street from him. Mr. Albanese said he has a contractor to fix the place up. He will check again tomorrow on the status of the contractor. Mr. Thomas questioned the Chief of Police about the Stop Sign on 33rd Avenue and 45th Street. No one is stopping there.

Mrs. Nellie Loftus gave the supervisors pictures of the water situation in front of her place. There was another discussion about the water situation. The supervisors will check it out this week.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for June, 2015 with a total of 49 calls was given to the supervisors. He had nothing new to report.

Fire Department: Alan Hickey was present. There was nine fire calls. Six in Daugherty Township and three in Pulaski. Mr. Hickey asked for a copy of the burning ordinance. People are not obeying the no burning in June, July and August. Mr. Margetic inquired about the merger with Daugherty Township Fire Department. Mr. Hickey said that it is on hold for the present time.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Mr. Thomas Albanese was present and his report for June will be put on file.

Roads: Mike Zachodni has been busy in June, working on the equipment, cutting grass and weed whacking, patching pot holes, litter patrol on 33rd Avenue, checking and cleaning catch basins, worked on the tractor, cut back on 47th Street and put gravel on 47th Street, installed a catch basin on 42nd Street, sweeping intersections after the storm and cleaned basins on 46th Street and 34th Avenue and planted grass on 33rd Avenue.
