

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Police Chief Ron Walton, Alan Hickey, Casey Zachodni, and Terry Johnson. Attorney Joseph M. Budicak was not present.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Kimberly Johnson to accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting of July 11, 2016. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mrs. Johnson, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay the bills. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mrs. Johnson, yes. The motion was carried.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Police:** Chief Walton was present. A report for July, 2016 with a total of 36 calls was given to the supervisors. The report will be put on file.

**Fire Department:** Alan Hickey was present. There were ten fire calls for July, 2016. There were three in Pulaski Township and seven fire calls in Daugherty Township. The report will be put on file.

**Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer:** Mr. Thomas Albanese was present. His report for July, 2016 was turned in and will be put on file. He has been asked about putting a kennel on a private property and doesn't seem to be able to find anything in our ordinance.

The question came up about the Mobile Home Park at Shadyside and Denman. New owners have purchased it and there seems to be a discussion of putting recreational vehicles on the lots. He stated that Daugherty Township is looking into adopting an ordinance regarding transient people. There seems to be some indication that The Shell Chemicals Plant in the old St. Joe Property wants to put transient workers on the properties. He suggested that that we should maybe consider adopting the same ordinance as Daugherty Township since the same owner owns property in Pulaski and Daugherty Township. Chief Walton said maybe we need to

consider vehicle registration, background checks, occupancy permits and put as many restrictions as we can to control the matter.

**Roads:** Mike Zachodni has been busy in July, working on the equipment, patching holes, litter patrol, cleaning basin tops, cutting grass, weed whacking, spraying weed killer, picking up branches, cutting branches on 43<sup>rd</sup> Street and trees on 44<sup>th</sup> Street and working on the tractor. The report will be put on file.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Kimberly Johnson to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mrs. Johnson, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Kim Johnson to donate \$100 to the New Brighton UP Foundation in memory of Ray "Rick" Smith, Mayor of New Brighton. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mrs. Johnson, yes. The motion was carried.
