

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
March 13, 2017**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Dwayne Bogolea, 3308 – 30th Avenue was present to complain about the trash at the end of 30th Avenue. It is a dead end street and there is plasterboard, tires, a Gazebo and he wants it all cleaned up. He said he can't even drive down there. Mrs. Griffith stated that she will have to cite both property owners on each side of the street.

Ed Stang was present to tell the supervisors he wants an ordinance about parking on the road. Fortieth Street is down to one lane sometimes. Brenda and Rick Stang have the same problem. They were told to put some kind of a barrier in the front of their property so no one can park there. Chief Walton stated that no one can park on the street. When the cars park off the road they are destroying the berm of the road.

Mrs. Sandra Fraser was present in relation to the cell tower pole on 42nd Avenue and Stang Street. She stated that it is on the curve and that someone is going to end up plowing into it. She also received an invoice for \$250.00. Attorney Budicak will check into the matter and a letter will be sent to the company.

Mrs. Griffith was asked about the Hanshe property, 3903 – 41st Avenue. How can someone live in a condemned house? She will check into the matter. The property is in the hands of the Beaver County Redevelopment Department for demolition.

CORRESPONDENCE

The minutes of the Beaver County Planning Commission of January 17, 2017 was received.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Walton was present. A report for February, 2017 with a total of 35 calls was given to the supervisors. The report will be put on file. He questioned about an ordinance regulating abandoned cars on township property.

Fire Department: Alan Hickey was present and reported nine fire calls in Daugherty Township for February and five fire calls in Pulaski Township. He told Mrs. Griffith, the Code Enforcement Officer, that there is a problem in Willow Tree Estates with electric meters on the poles in the last five trailers. She will check into the matter.

Code Enforcement and Zoning Officer: Mrs. Griffith was present. Her report will be put on file.

Recreation: The minutes of the March 6, 2017 New Brighton Recreation Commission were submitted and will be put on file. There will be a St. Patrick's Day Race 5K on March 18th, a Triathlon on May 27th and an Upcoming Bus Trip to Rivers Casino on April 29, 2017.

Roads: Mike Zachodni has been busy in February .fixing signs on Cemetery Road, 37th Avenue and 38th Avenue, Mixing Anti-Skid//Salt, patching holes, picking up debris from the storm and plowing and salting. The report will be put on file.
