**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

The fee for the DEP Permit is \$500 and has to be submitted before September 26<sup>th</sup>. The Ordinance will be in effect for five years. The annual fee for the permit to the DEP is \$500. The retention pond will consist of a manufactured vault installed in the ground and hopefully it will last for ten years. It will have to be cleaned every so often to keep it clear. No one had any questions for Mr. Sell.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Kimberly Keener Johnson to adopt the Ordinance #248 for MS4 Stormwater Management to amend the Ordinance #228. . Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, absent and Mrs. Johnson, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Kimberly Keener Johnson to adopt Ordinance #249 - Amendment to Ordinance #110 and Revision A-220 Per Capita Taxes. This sets the penalty on delinquent per capita at 10%. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, absent and Mrs. Johnson, yes. The motion was carried.
