A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to adopt the 2018 Meeting Schedule. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mrs. Johnson, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to purchase a new 2018 - 450 truck from Co-Stars in the amount of \$71, 131. There was some discussion. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mrs. Johnson, no. The motion was carried.
