TRAFFIC SIGNS MANAGEMENT PLAN

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PULASKI,
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.**

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration promulgated the 2009 Edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, including Revisions 1 and 23 in May 2012 (“MUTCO”);

WHEREAS, the **MUTCO** defines standards and guidance for the design, placement, application, maintenance and uniformity of traffic control devices in the United States.

WHEREAS, **PennDot** adopted the **MUTCO** pursuant Chapter 212 of Title 67 of the Pennsylvania Code.

WHEREAS, the **MUTCO** requires that the Township of Pulaski implement and use an assessment and management method that is designed to maintain regulatory and warning sign retro reflectivity at or above the established minimum levels on or before June 13, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Pulaski has developed a Sign Management Plan dated January 3, 2012 (the “sign Management plan”), attached hereto as Exhibit A, which exceeds the requirements of the **MUTCO** requirements by creating a management method of Township owned signs, including Regulatory Signs, Post-Mounted Guide Signs, Warning Signs and Street Name Signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township of Pulaski hereby adopts the Sign Management Plan and directs the Street Department to implement and carry out the Sign Management Plan.

The Township of Pulaski hereby certify that the foregoing is a true copy of the Township of Pulaski Resolution #373 adopted June 9, 2014.
