A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF PULASKI TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORZING, EMPOWERING AND DIRECTING THE PROPER OFFICERS OF THE GOVERNING BOARD TO APPOINT A LIASON BETWEEN IT AND BERKHEIMER, THE DULY APPOINTED COLLECTOR OF THE PER CAPITA TAX FOR THE DISTRICT, FOR THE EXPRESS PURPOSE OF SHARING CONFIDENTIAL TAX INFORMATION WITH THE DISTRICT FOR OFFICIAL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Local Tax Enabling Act ("LTEA"), authorizes certain political subdivisions, including PULASKI TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, to provide for the creation of such bureaus or the appointment and compensation of such officers, clerks, collectors and other assistants and employees as may be deemed necessary for the assessment and collection of taxes imposed under the authority of that Act; and

WHEREAS, PULASKI TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY has entered into contractual agreement with BERKEHIMER of Bangor, Pennsylvania, whereby and whereunder PULASKI TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, appointed Berkheimer to collect PER CAPITA TAX; and

WHEREAS, the LTEA specifically mandates that any information gained by the appointed tax officer, his agents or by any other official or agent of the taxing district, as a result of any declarations, returns, investigations, hearings or verifications required or authorized by the taxing municipality's ordinance or resolution, be kept confidential, except for official purposes; and

WHEREAS, any person who divulges any information which is confidential under the provisions of any ordinance or resolution, upon conviction may be subject to fines and/or imprisonment, upon conviction, and dismissal from office or discharge from employment; and

WHEREAS, Berkheimer requires passage of a resolution by the governing body of PULASKI TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, specifying that said confidential information is needed for official purposes and absolving Berkheimer from any liability in connection with the release of said confidential information:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. PULASKI TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, hereby appoints Kimberly Keener Johnson, as its authorized representative to make requests upon and receive any and all tax information and record from Berkheimer, relative to the collection of taxes for PULASKI

TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, as desired and deemed necessary by PULASKI TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY, to be used for official purposes only; and

- 2. Berkheimer is hereby directed to provide and/or transmit any and all tax information and records, or any portion thereof, relating to the collection of taxes for Pulaski Township, upon request, to Kimberly Keener Johnson, as the authorized contact representative for it.
- 3. **PULASKI TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY,** hereby saves harmless, indemnifies and/or absolves Berkheimer from and against any and all liability in connection with the release of said confidential information.
