RESOLUTION #397

A resolution of the Township of Pulaski, County of Beaver, New Brighton, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania fixing the tax rate for the year 2018.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED and it is hereby resolved and enacted this 11th day of December, 2017 by the Board of Township Supervisors of the Township of Pulaski, County of Beaver, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, appropriating specific sums estimated to be required for the specific purposes of the municipal government, hereinafter set forth, during the year 2018.

That for the expenditures and revenues of the fiscal year 2018 the following amounts are hereby appropriated from the fund equities, revenues and other financing sources available for the year 2018 for the specific purposes set forth. General Fund \$391,345.00, Revenue \$513,370.00 and State Aid \$64,207.00. The tax rate for general debt purposes, the sum of 13 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation. There is no increase in millage.

Any resolution conflicting with this resolution be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this resolution.
