

PULASKI TOWNSHIP

Resolution No. 329  
Beaver County UCC Appeals Board

WHEREAS, VARIOUS MUNICIPALITIES WITHIN beaver County have investigated the possibility of having in place a countywide Appeals Board that would be ready to hear all hearings from any municipality within Beaver County, without any requirement that the municipality enter into any intergovernmental cooperative agreement;

AND, WHEREAS, The Beaver County Labor Council does wish to serve the local governments within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code against any of the local governments within Beaver County;

AND, WHEREAS, the Beaver County Labor Council has agreed to serve in that capacity with the following to be understood:

1. The Labor Council has agreed to serve as the Chairman of the Beaver County UCC Appeals Board.
2. Each of the Labor Council's member unions will, at all times, have a delegate and an alternate ready to serve upon request from any Beaver County municipal government which has indicated their desire to participate.
3. When contacted by the municipality, The Council will seek a board of five (5) representatives to hear the appeal from the delegates/alternates of record.

AND, WHEREAS, each participating municipality has agreed that, in order to avail themselves of the Beaver County UCC Appeals Board's services, it will:

1. Establish a fee for the appeal process.

2. Accept an application from the aggrieved party.
3. Contact the Beaver County Labor Council's office to request a hearing.
4. Contact the Beaver County Sheriff's Office to reserve the room.
5. Pay for the cost of the following: Legal counsel, stenographer and legal advertisement. Collection for reimbursement by the appellant shall be done at the discretion of the municipality.

AND, WHEREAS, it is further understood that there will be no fee for the use of the Board itself or for the room. All hearings will take place on the same day (normally the second Thursday of each month, third Thursday if the second Thursday is a County-observed holiday, with the fourth Thursday to be utilized in the event of multiple requests) of every month, in order for the delegates and alternates to allocate their time.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that until further notice, the governing body of the Township of Pulaski, County of Beaver, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, does hereby indicate its intent to utilize the Beaver County UCC Appeals Board for all appeals under the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code.
