RESOLUTION NO. 332

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PULASKI AUTHORIZING THE PARTICIPATION OF THE TOWNSHIP IN THE 2005-2006 WINTER COMMODITIES CONTRACT ADMINISTERED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANBERRY, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, Section 1902 of Act 57 of May 15, 1998 (Title 62 PA. C.S. 1902), known as the Commonwealth Procurement Codes, permits local public procurement units, including local municipalities and authorities, to sponsor, establish, participate in, conduct, or administer a cooperative purchasing agreement for the procurement of any goods, materials, equipment, or services with another local public procurement unit; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Pulaski and the Township of Cranberry are local public procurement units as defined by the Commonwealth Procurement Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Cranberry has bid and entered into a Winter Commodities Contract for snow and ice control materials for the 2005-2006 winter season, and

WHEREAS, the Township of Pulaski understands that the Township of Cranberry has complied with the requirements governing its procurement of supplies and services; and

WHEREAS, the bid documents provide for cooperative purchases by local public procurement units from any contract resulting from the solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Procurement Code provides that where the public procurement unit administering a cooperative purchase complies with the requirements governing its procurement of services and supplies, any public procurement unit participating in the purchase shall be deemed to have complied with the requirements governing its procurement of supplies and services, Title 62 PA. C.S. ' 1908; and

WHEREAS, IT IS DEEMED TO BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE Township of Pulaski to participate in the 2005-2006 Winter Commodities Contract, which is administered by the Township of Cranberry as a cooperative purchase and the Township agrees to be bound by the terms of the bid document and award as offered by the Township of Cranberry.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

1. The Township is authorized to participate in Cranberry Township's 2005-2006 Winter Commodities Contract, based upon the terms and conditions of the contract and at the same prices. Further, the Township of Pulaski shall be responsible for the payment of the price directly to the contractor of said expenses directly related to those purchased.
2. Specific purchases to be made under the Cranberry Township 2005-2006 Winter Commodities Contract shall be pursuant to normal purchasing procedures established by the Board.
