**THIS RESOLUTION, approved and adopted by the Township
of Pulaski, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, on the date hereinafter set forth.**

WITNESSETH:

Whereas, Section 7503 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 PA C.S.A. Section 7107 et. seg. Mandates that PULASKI TOWNSHIP prepare, maintain and keep current an Emergency Operations Plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster within this TOWNSHIP; AND

WHEREAS, in response to the mandate stated above, this TOWNSHIP has prepared an Emergency Operations Plan to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster; AND

WHEREAS, this TOWNSHIP has also prepared an Emergency Operations Plan in order to reduce the potential affects of a major emergency or disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this TOWNSHIP.

NOW THEREFORE, be it duly resolved by the undersigned BOARD OF SUPERVISORS do hereby approve, adopt and place into immediate effect the Emergency Operations Plan of PULASKI TOWNSHIP. This Plan shall be reviewed on an annual basis to make certain that it conforms with the requirements of the Beaver County Emergency Operations Plan.
