The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the minutes of the December 12, 2011 meeting and Close the Year Meeting, December 30, 2011 and the Reorganizational Meeting of January 3, 2012. **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Police:** Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for December with a total of 58 calls was turned in to the supervisors. He had nothing to report.

**Fire Department:** Scott Roeder, Fire Chief, gave the Chairman a report that there were five fire calls last month. Three were in Pulaski and two were in Daugherty. The Department had a total of sixty five calls for the year.

**Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer:** Mr. John Clay, Code Enforcement Officer, was present. He reported that he had five calls and tagged six vehicles. He was at the fire on 38<sup>th</sup> Street and is still involved with that.

**Recreation Commission:** Mr. Barr was in attendance. He announced that the January meeting of the Recreation Commission was postponed until tomorrow, January 10, 2012 at 7:00 P. M. He said that he will not serve as an alternate to the Recreation Commission.

**Roads:** Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy picking up leaves and branches, cleaning catch basins and working on the equipment., worked on signs, the air compressor and the red light and was salting and plowing snow..

Mr. Donn Sheets had a question for the Supervisors. He wanted to know why something can't be done about vehicles that don't have a title and abandoned vehicles. Attorney Budicak stated that residents are permitted to have one unlicensed uninspected vehicle and there is no time limit on how long they can have one. Chief Van Fossan said the police have no authority on private property.

Mrs. Gallagher was present in reference to the water problem they have on New England Hill and Mr. Margetic and Mr. Hage want to meet with them.

### **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Mr. Margetic announced that there will not be a community clean-up day next year. The money is needed for doing roads, which is more important.

The next Regular Meeting will be held on Monday, February 13, 2012 at 6:30 P. M.

The Supervisors went into executive session at 6:58 P. M. A discussion was held about the law suit for the 2010 Truck. Attorney Budicak was told to start the law suit. Mr. Margetic suggested that maybe Attorney Budicak should contact PSATS about the problem since New Holland Auto Group has such a huge advertisement in their monthly magazine. They should know what has happened with New Holland about our truck. Also, he was instructed to the possible suing of Ford Motors.

There was a discussion in reference to the Hovancik, Krause and Park properties. Attorney Budicak was told to proceed with the cases that are filed. Mr. Albert Hovancik has appealed his notice and there will have to be a meeting with the Supervisors and Mr. Hovancik.

Mr. Margetic told Mr. Clay that Mr. Liberty's truck has a current license plate and insurance that Mr. Clay had towed. It is not illegal for him to have it and it should have never been towed..

Attorney Budicak said that the John Reeher property is in foreclosure.
