Mrs. Carol Gossard wanted to know if there would be a clean-up this year. The Township does not have the funds available for a clean-up this year.

It was pointed out to the Supervisors that the right of way on 52<sup>nd</sup> Street should be named Helbling Avenue (Private Drive) on the new map.
