

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
June 11, 2012**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for May with a total of 74 calls was turned in to the supervisors. He had nothing to report. He was questioned about the vandalism in the township. He said there was and it is happening everywhere.

Fire Department: Scott Roeder, Fire Chief gave the Chairman a report that there were three fire calls.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Ms. Dawn L. Pella was not present. She turned in her report for May. It will be put in the file. At the end of June all the people with second notices will be cited if they do not do what she requested.

Recreation Commission: Mrs. Kruse was in attendance. She turned in her report for the month. The Triathlon held on Saturday, May, 2012 was a success. One hundred seven people participated. The Recreation Board made a profit of \$1,278. There were two accidents on bicycles in the Triathlon. Nothing real serious. August 4, 2012 there were by a Kickball Tournament at the Grove Avenue Field. Prizes, trophies, T-shirts etc. will be given out. The

Summer Playground Program will start on June 18th. It will be held in Pulaski Township (Projects) twice a week. Her report will be put on file.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy with cutting grass, weed wacking, fixing signs, installing a catch basin and fixing the red light. Donn Sheets stated that he thought Mike should have help when putting in a catch basin. Mr. Margetic said that the Borough should help when he doing something like that, since Mike helps them when they need help. Mike was supposed to let Mr. Margetic know when he was doing it so that he could help him.

OLD BUSINESS

Attorney Budicak said that the Rental Unit Ordinance is ready to go. We have three Ordinances on Rental Units and he suggested that maybe it would be better to combine them into one Ordinance. It would good to check with Mrs. Pella and get her input into the ordinance since she will be the one enforcing it.

Paper for the Truck where filed last week. We have thirty to forty-five days that we should know what happens.

He has talked to Randy Dawson at the 911 Center. He should have the maps to him this week. Mr. Dawson will need a list of old addresses that are being changed and the new address, names, etc. to proceed.

Attorney Budicak asked the supervisors if they want him to send a letter to William Spooner of 40th Street in reference to the paving of Rochester Alley. Mr. Spooner wants to pave the Alley and Attorney Budicak said that is a private road and that should be between Mr. Spooner and his neighbors. He will write a letter telling him that in no way the Township will be responsible for the upkeep of the road. The Supervisors instructed him to write the letter.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to advertise for bids for paving in the Township. Jeff Frye of Herbert, Rowland & Grubic Inc. will engineer the project. Roads to be done are 46th Street from Rochester Road to the top, 41st Street from 43rd Street to 39th Avenue and a 10 x 100 foot stretch behind the fire department. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATON

George Doyle questioned about the properties of Hovancik and Eakles (Krause Property) on 41st Street. The one house is to be demolished by the County and proceedings at the District

Justice Office have to be scheduled. Attorney Budicak and Dawn Pella have to get together to proceed.
