

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for June with a total of 68 calls was given to the supervisors. He had nothing else to report. Mr. Kirish brought up the subject of all the cars speeding on 33rd Avenue. Mr. Mooney said the police need to watch speeding on 47th Street and Mrs. Kelly said she has a problem on 44th Street also.

Fire Department: Scott Roeder was present for the Fire Department. He reported that there were three fires in New Brighton and two in Pulaski Township and three in Daugherty.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Ms. Dawn L. Pella was not present. There was no report from her. Mr. Margetic said that he has spoken with Mrs. Pella and gave her free reigns to do what she needs to do to get the township cleaned up. She stated that fiscally she couldn't do everything we want accomplished. She is doing her best.

Recreation Commission: Mrs. Kruse was not in attendance.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy with cutting grass and weed whacking, painted the garage doors, cleaning catch basins, worked on the tractor and cleaned up debris after the storm. Mr. Margetic told Mrs. Massie that when we pave this year something will be done about the road at the top of her place to keep the big debris from going on her property.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Attorney Budicak stated that Ford motor did respond about the truck. There has been some movement, but the progress is slow.

NEW BUSINESS

There was a discussion about vacant property and cutting grass. Attorney Budicak stated that if the Township wants to pay someone to cut the grass and bill the Township for the services, then he will file a lien against the property. The lien will cover expenses for the cutting, court costs, legal fees, and interest. When the property is sold the township will recover their expenses. Attorney Budicak said that is now time to start a civil suit in the Court House against the property owners that will not clean up their property. He was given the go ahead from the Supervisors.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATON

Mr. Kelly wants speed bumps on 44th Street. The Township is not permitted to put speed bumps on any of their roads. She asked about the catch basin on 44th Street. She said that it is caving in and one of these times a vehicle will fall in it.

Mr. Kirish is complaining about the property across the street from him. He said they burn all the time and they are even burning garbage. He is to get the property owners name and address and the secretary will send them a letter. He was also told to call the police when they are burning.
