

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
August 8, 2011**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Jim Barr, Debbie and Ray Hickman, Norman Bible, John Malack, George and Kathy Zilk, Joe Zilk, George Doyle, Wayne Everly, Scott Roeder, Mark Kehoe, Mike Beaver, and Attorney Budicak.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the minutes of the July 11, 2011 and Work Session of June 15, 2011. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for July with a total of 52 calls was turned in to the supervisors. He had nothing to report.

Fire Department: Scott Roeder, Fire Chief was present. He reported there were four fire calls in Pulaski and five in Daugherty. Mr. George Zilk asked about the fire whistle. Mr. Roeder said they were given an estimate of \$10,000 to replace the fire whistle. Mr. Zilk said that Mr. Hage had someone to look at it, if the firemen would have it taken down. Mr. Zilk said that in case of an emergency the citizens wouldn't know about it when the whistle doesn't work. Mr. Roeder stated that each fireman has a pager and they are notified when there is a fire call.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Mr. John Clay, Code Enforcement Officer, was not present. He never reported that he wasn't coming.

Recreation: Mr. Barr was in attendance. He turned in a report on the Recreation Commission summer playground. Pulaski had a total of 25 in attendance with a daily average of 14 children. He did state that the playgrounds are doing really well. Davies Developmental Day Care LLC has done a fantastic job of supplying the lunch for the children. Mr. Barr announced that the Commission has received a grant to revamp the baseball field behind the Middle School. They will be meeting with the contractor on the 15th to discuss the project.

Roads: Mike has been busy cutting grass, weed wacking, fixing signs, working on the tractor and picking up branches. Mr. Mooney is against the fire department burning a house down on 46th Street. Tom Sipes, who bid for trimming trees, has finished that project. Mr. Barr asked if the catch basin on 40th Avenue and 49th Street could be cleaned. It is plugged up.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Attorney Budicak stated that he is waiting for Charles Nail and Mrs. Boyd Blinn to return the papers for the agreement on 49th Street. Once that is done, then the road will be maintained by the township. Mr. Margetic said that road would be on the list to be paved. The supervisors don't have any idea when that will take place.

He is still working on the ordinance for the vacating of streets, alleys and roads. He will send a copy to the supervisors to review and at the September meeting the ordinance can be adopted.

He has heard nothing about the truck. He said he will probably have to start court proceedings.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to enter into an Easement Agreement with George and Beverly Zilk, 4323 – 33rd Lane, New Brighton for the placement and installation of a storm sewer draining pipe and the maintenance of same. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes, Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to make a donation of \$100.00 to Boy Scout Troop #427 for all the litter cleanup they have done on Sunflower Road, 43rd Street, 33rd Avenue, Blockhouse Run Road and Cemetery Lane. They have done an excellent job of cleanup. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes, Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

Mr. Hage announced that the salt bid with Co-Stars came in at \$61.16 for 2011.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mr. Barr thanked Attorney Budicak for all the work he has done in reference to 49th Street.

Mr. & Mrs. George Zilk thanked the supervisors for taking care of the terrible water situation on 4323 – 33rd Lane. The damages to their home and pool were extensive and the township put in two catch basins and a sewer line to hopefully alleviate the problem from happening again.

Mr. Bible said they lost power for about seven hours when a tree limb fell on the wires in the last storm. He wants that tree cut down. It is on private property. He brought the subject of all the junk on the street behind his home. Mr. Beaver wouldn't talk to him and he wants all that junk moved out. Mr. Beaver was present and they got into a discussion about the situation. Mr. Beaver has purchased a building and he is getting it ready so that he can move all the cars, equipment, etc. as soon as possible. He is waiting on an occupancy permit and electrical permit.

Mrs. Hickman asked Attorney Budicak about the property to be vacated. She wanted to know if the residents will be getting a letter when it is final. The Supervisors agreed that a letter could be sent residents. Attorney Budicak said that the letters do not need to be sent certified.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Mr. Margetic reminded the citizens that school will be starting on August 29th and to be very careful when driving. He wished everyone a safe Labor Day celebration.

A work session will be held on September 12, 2011 at 5:30 P. M.

The next regular meeting will be held on Monday, September 12, 2011 at 6:30 P. M.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Bryon Mooney to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 P. M. Vote the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.
