WORK SESSION

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 P. M.

Those In Attendance were: George Hage, Casey Zachodni. and Tina Kruse.

Open for discussion was the following:

The Christian and Missionary Alliance Church has asked if the members could get involved in the community. They would like to have a litter pick-up. Their insurance carrier will cover anyone involved. Mable Henn contacted the Township Insurance Carrier, Chief Ron Walton, Chief of Police and Attorney Budicak and they all agreed they don't have a problem with it. The Chief of Police did say they would supply vest, sticks and a patrol car if they do Sunflower Road or 43rd Street as a precautionary when they do those two streets. Also, he gave her a copy of a waiver and release form release of liability they we can use. The supervisors all agreed that it would be a good program.

A PA One call came in for 49th Street and 40th Avenue. There is no place to run the water for a catch basin. The supervisors are not in agreement with it. The secretary was instructed to contact PA One and tell them that Todd Beegle cannot dig.

Mr. Hage questioned where is the leaf machine? Casey Zachodni told him that it is being repaired.

Also, a part for the leaf machine is lying in the salt bin and will be ruined.

Mr. Hage noted that the louvers in the back of salt shed are in dire need of repair and also the roof needs repaired. Shingles are missing. The secretary was asked to get three bids to replace the (steel) louvers and put a premium shingle on it. Also, a bid for a steel roof on the salt bins. The roof on the township building needs painted. Bids are to be received for that too.
