

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
October 10, 2011**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the minutes of the September 12, 2011 meeting. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay the bills. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for September with a total of 64 calls was turned in to the supervisors. He had nothing to report. No one had questions for him.

Fire Department: Scott Roeder, Fire Chief was present. He reported that there were three fires in September. Two were in Pulaski and one in Daugherty Township.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Mr. John Clay, Code Enforcement Officer, was not present.

Recreation: Mr. Barr was in attendance. He reported that the bids for the baseball field behind the Middle School were opened bids on September 20th and a company from out in the Mid

West was awarded the bid. The bid was for \$284,000. Mr. Barr voted no because he felt it should be awarded to someone in this area.

Roads: Mr. Mooney reported that Mike has been busy cutting grass, weed whacking, cleaning catch basins, putting gravel on the berm of the roads. Mr. Sheets stated that the catch basin in front of his house is still not cleaned out.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Bryon Mooney to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

OLD BUSINESS

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to adopt a Deed of Dedication between the Township and Charles F. and Lou Ann Nail. This is in reference to 49th Street. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to adopt a Deed of Dedication between the Township and Mark Kehoe and Natalia Blinn. This is in reference to 49th Street. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to adopt Resolution #352 for the acceptance of the dedication of 49th Street as a public roadway in Pulaski Township. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to adopt Ordinance #235 for the vacating of public right of ways in the township. A copy is attached. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Bryon Mooney to make a donation of \$100.00 to the New Brighton Halloween Parade Committee. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to appoint George Muska, 3323 Sunflower Road, New Brighton to fill the unexpired term of Mrs. Ina Weber to the Pulaski Township Planning Commission. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to adopt Resolution #353 Establishment of a UCC Regional Board of Appeals through the Beaver County Regional Council of Governments. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Donn Sheets was present to say that the catch basin in front of his property needs a trough to make the water run into the catch basin. The rain is washing all his gravel down into the woods. Also, would the Supervisors ask the New Brighton Sanitary Authority to flush out the sewers on 39th Street?

Mr. Doyle wanted to know who is responsible to remove the gravel when it washes out onto the roads. He was told that it is the road department. The Borough of New Brighton comes up with their piece of equipment and sweeps the streets. There is a problem when it rains with the gravel washing down from 37th Way and the township is trying to find a way to correct the matter.

Mrs. Margetic stated that the Fire Department is doing much better now.

There was a discussion between Mr. Bible and Mr. Beaver. Mr. Beaver claims he gets all the water from off everyone else's property. He wants the supervisors to run a pipe so the water will run down over the hillside or he could run the water into the storm sewer. The Supervisors will look at the situation and see what can be resolved.

Gary Krause registered a complaint about the people who trimmed the trees. He said they even cut back on his property. He said something needs done about the old Brewer property. They don't trim the trees, grass and there is a lot of trash on 43rd Street. He complained that Mr. Clay is not doing his job correctly. Mr. Bianco from Beaver County Redevelopment told him that Mr. Clay should be getting papers from them to have houses condemned.
