

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
October 13, 2014**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Don Moore, Bill Thomas, Ray and Debbie Hickman, Police Chief VanFossan and Attorney Budicak.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for September, 2014 with a total of 55 calls was given to the supervisors. He had nothing new to report.

Fire Department: Alan Hickey was present. He reported that there were three calls in Daugherty and one in Pulaski for the month of September. In October there were two in Daugherty, three in Pulaski and one in New Brighton. He stated that the Fire department is not going to dissolve. They have a grant over \$12,000 for radios and they have to have it for one year or else return the grant to the State.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Mr. Thomas Albanese was present and his report for September will be put on file. He inquired of the supervisors in relation to property on 47th Street that was purchased and the new owner wants to put three apartments in it. It is R-2 Two Family Zoned, and, if it is made into three apartments they would be considered commercial and would have to have a sprinkler system installed which is quite expensive and the supervisors would have to vote for conditional use. Mr. Margetic stated that he has been in the house and doesn't feel it is big enough to make three apartments out of it.

Recreation Commission: James McCullough was not present.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy cutting grass, weed whacking, hauling anti-skid, picking up branches and working with the paving of the roads. A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

Attorney Budicak said he mailed a letter to Kevin Ferguson last week in reference to him serving as an Auditor. He has not heard from him and neither has the Secretary.

He said that DeJana wants to have Ford kick in on the cost of the repairs to the truck and he told the representative that he wants an answer this week.

Attorney Budicak checked into the situation with the Fire Department and reported that the dissolution would have to be done by resolution. Mr. Hickey said they have a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer and five trustees. Attorney Budicak advised them to hold off on merger talks until the first part of November. Mr. Hickey said they can't do anything until after June, 2015.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to adopt Ordinance #243 Renaming of Certain Streets and Roadways in the Township to clarify better different addresses in the Township for emergency services personnel. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mr. Thomas wanted to know from Mr. Albanese about the duplex across the street from him on 46th Street. When they will be inspected. Mr. Albanese said that there has not been any scheduled appointment in inspection set up yet.

Mr. Moore wanted to know why the Township doesn't merge the fire departments. Daugherty Township would be closer. He inquired about the cost of a merger. There has been no discussion on that yet.

Leaf pickup will begin on October 27th and the schedule will be put in the paper and it does appear on the Website.
