

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
November 14, 2011**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the minutes of the October 10, 2011 meeting and Budget Meeting, October 17, 2011. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for October with a total of 46calls was turned in to the supervisors. He had nothing to report. No one had questions for him.

Fire Department: Scott Roeder, Fire Chief was present. He reported that there were seven fires in October. One fire was in Pulaski.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Mr. John Clay, Code Enforcement Officer, was present. He had seven complaints and tagged four cars. He reported that the civil charges filed at the District Justice Office - one complaint was found guilty and two were continued. He reported that Pulaski Homes will be applying for building permits shortly. He attended a meeting in reference to FEMA and flood control. Our only concern is Blockhouse Run.

Recreation: Mr. Barr was in attendance. Mr. Barr reported that he had talked to the contractor working on the baseball field behind the Middle School and by the end of the month they will be one week ahead of schedule.

Roads: Mr. Mooney reported that Mike has been busy cutting grass, weed whacking, cleaning catch basins, put gravel on 39th Street, patching streets, put gravel along the side of the roads, picking up leaves and branches and he posted signs for paving, swept the streets for paving and helped when the roads where paved in the township.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Bryon Mooney to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

OLD BUSINESS

There was no old business to be brought before the Board.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Byron Mooney to adopt the tentative proposed budget for the 2012 year. The budget will be in the Township office for anyone wishing to inspect it. Final adoption will be at the December 12, 2011 board meeting. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mr. Sheets was present to find out what is being done about Albert Hovancik. He thought the hearing on the 25th was for Albert, but it was for his son, James.

Mrs. Hickman questioned about the Halloween Trick or Treat Night. Chief Van Fossan told her they changed the date to the 31st to correlate with the rest of the towns in Beaver County.

Mr. Doyle stated that a boy came down out of 38th Way and slid into his car with his bicycle. He said the gravel needs to have something done with it. Mr. Margetic stated that the Borough did come up and suck up some of the loose gravel. Maybe it will have be done again. He wanted to know how many more roads are going to be done. There will be no more done this year.

Mr. Muska was present in reference to his neighbor cutting his trees down. Mr. Muska talked to Mr. Clay later about the matter.

Mr. Bible was present again about the water situation down by him. Mr. Margetic said he will talk to Mr. Beaver and see if it can't be resolved. Mr. Mooney told Mr. Clay that Mr. Beaver needs to cut his weeds that are three foot high.

Gary Krause wanted to know what was happening with his house. Attorney Budicak said he sent the papers to the Community Development. Mr. Krause said he heard that the Fire Department was going to be burning it down. There is no truth to that matter. He said that someone broke into the house again.
