

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE #240**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PULASKI, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO AMEND ORDINANCE # 237 AS ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 10, 2012 PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF RENTAL UNITS AND ALSO FOR THE INSPECTION OF SUCH UNITS BY THE TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Township of Pulaski, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I – PART I, Section IV(2)(a) is hereby amended to read as follows: All requirements of Section VI pertaining to inspection are met.

SECTION II – Section IV(a) is hereby amended to add (9) as one of the reasons for the requirement of an inspection as follows: All current and future rental units shall be subject to an initial inspection. If the initial inspection results in a Certificate of Safety, then the same shall be valid for a period of three (3) years from the date thereof unless an earlier inspection is required under one of the other provisions of this sub-section.

SECTION III – In all other respects the Ordinance known as Pulaski Township Ordinance 237 adopted September 10, 2012 shall remain the same.
