

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP**

**ORDINANCE #250**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PULASKI, BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ADOPTING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION BETWEEN DAUGHERTY TOWNSHIP, PULASKI TOWNSHIP, AND NEW BRIGHTON BOROUGH TO ESTABLISH A REGIONAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY.**

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Township Supervisors of the Township of Pulaski, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. An Agreement, entitled “New Brighton Area Emergency Management Agency – An Intergovernmental Agreement of Cooperation” dated November 13, 2017, herein after referred to as “Agreement” or “Regional EMA Agreement”, between Daugherty Township, Pulaski Township, and New Brighton Borough, a copy of which is attached hereto as “Exhibit A” and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted and approved by the Township of Pulaski.

Section 2. As required by the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, the following matters are specifically found and determined:

- A. The conditions of the agreement are as set forth in the Regional EMA Agreement, dated November 13, 2017, and are adopted by reference, with the same effect as if it had been set out verbatim in this Section, a copy of which shall be filed with the Minutes of the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted.
- B. The duration of the initial term of the Agreement, is five (5) years, after which Pulaski Township’s participation is as set forth in the Regional EMA Agreement dated November 13, 2017.
- C. The purpose and objectives of the agreement, including the powers and scope of authority delegated in the agreement, are as set forth in the Regional EMA Agreement dated November 13, 2017.
- D. The manner and extent of financing are as set forth in the Regional EMA Agreement dated November 13, 2017.
- E. The Board of Supervisors Chairperson and the Township Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to sign the Agreement on behalf of the Township of Pulaski.
- F. The Agreement marked as “Exhibit A” is entered into by and between the Participants pursuant to the authority granted to the Participants by the Area

Government and Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 1996, Dec. 19, P.L. 1158, No. 177 (53 Pa. C.S.A. §2301 et seq.).

- G. The Agreement shall be in full force and effect upon the execution of said Agreement by all of the Participants and the adoption by the Participants of an Ordinance or Resolution authorizing the same.

Section 3. By the passage of this Ordinance, the Township of Pulaski is hereby authorized to enter into intergovernmental cooperation agreements with additional municipalities for the provision of emergency management services through the passage of a resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 4. The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
