**Adopting the Beaver County
All-Hazard Mitigation Plan**

Whereas, Pulaski Township recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars, and

Whereas, Pulaski Township participated jointly in the planning process with the other local units of government within the County to prepare an All Hazard Mitigation Plan;

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the Pulaski Township Board of Supervisors, hereby adopts the Beaver County All-Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

Be it further resolved, that Beaver County Office of Emergency Services will submit on behalf of the participating municipalities the adopted All-Hazard Mitigation Plan to Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval.
