

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP

A motion was made by Kimberly Keener Johnson and seconded by Casey Zachodni to approve the minutes of the December 11, 2017, Close the Year Meeting, December 28, 2017 and the Reorganization Meeting, January 2, 2018. A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Kimberly Keener Johnson to donate \$100.00 to the Upper Beaver Valley Veteran’s Service Center for 2018. There was some discussion. The vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mrs. Johnson, yes and Mr. Zachodni, yes. The motion was carried.
