**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Police:** Chief Charles Van Fossan was present. A report for December with a total of 52 calls was turned in to the supervisors. He had nothing to report. No one had questions for him.

**Fire Department:** Scott Roeder, the new Fire Chief, and Alan Hickey were present. Mr. Rich Morrell turned in a report for the year 2010. He reported that there were calls 15 Fire Alarms, 11 Structure Fires, 34 Mutual Aid Calls/Assist, 9 Motor Vehicle Accidents, 25 service calls for a total of 94 calls. Mr. Margetic thanked Mr. Morrell for his many years of service to the Fire Department and the Community.

**Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer:** Mr. John Clay, Code Enforcement Officer, was present. He reported he had no building permits for December and tagged 17 vehicles of which many were removed. He had one towed today. He had four complaints. He is working on a serious problem at the property of Mr. Maga on Blockhouse Run Road and the property next to it.

**Recreation:** Mr. Barr was in attendance. He had nothing new to report.

**Roads:** Mr. Mooney announced that he is in charge of roads this year.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to name John F. Clay as the Emergency Management Coordinator for the Township for 2011. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

Mr. Mooney wanted to change Mike Zachodni's hours on meeting night so that he could attend the meeting. After some discussion and some input from Attorney Budicak, it was decided not to change his hours. As Chairman of the Roads, it should be Mr. Mooney reporting on roads. There is no need to have Mr. Zachodni there unless a matter would arise that he would be asked to attend the meeting.

### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

Mr. Everly brought up the subject again about 46<sup>th</sup> Street. There is nothing that the Supervisors can do to correct the condition on that street. It has been like that forever and their hands are tied as to what can be done. It has been discussed with the Engineer, Penn Dot representatives and it is not feasible to do what Mr. Everly and Mr. Johnson want done. The matter is closed now.

Mr. Margetic announced that the next meeting will be held on Monday, February 14, 2011 at 6:30 P. M.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to adjourn the meeting and go into Executive Session 6:52 P. M. After some discussion they went back into session and the meeting was adjourned at 7:05 P. M. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.
