**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Police:** Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for December with a total of 39 calls was given to the supervisors. He reported that nothing is going on. Chief VanFossan said that he had talked to the Beaver County Humane Society and they said that they are checking on the situation.

**Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer:** Ms. Dawn L. Pella was not present. Her report will be put on file.

The Borough Manager, Larry Morley, was present and gave a presentation on the property rental and zoning that is in place with the Borough. The Supervisors are contemplating going with the Borough on some of rental and inspections. Mr. Morley will check with the Borough Council and schedule a meeting sometime next week to meet with the Supervisors and discuss the matters.
