

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP

Mr. Stang stated that he would be willing to help the township to fix it.

Mr. Giansanti was present and asked about the property at 3400 – 47th Street. He was told by the Solicitor to check about delinquent real estate taxes in the court House first. He was told there is a lien against the property for over \$8,000.00 that will need to be satisfied also.

Roads: Mike Zachodni was busy in December with cleaning equipment, picking up leaves, cleaning catch basin tops, litter patrol on 41st Street and 33rd Avenue, patching pot holes, working on the leaf machine and salting the roads.
