**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Police:** Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for February, 2015 with a total of 33 calls was given to the supervisors. He had nothing new to report.

**Fire Department:** Alan Hickey turned in a report that there was eight fire calls in February - six in Daugherty Township, and two in Pulaski. The report will be put on file.

**Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer:** Mr. Thomas Albanese was present and his report for February will be put on file. He stated that he hasn't heard from FEMA in reference to an ordinance that needs adopted, but we have until August to adopt it. Also, the Hanshe house on 41st Avenue has been condemned. The owner is incarcerated so Mr. Albanese could not talk to him. The home was destroyed by fire.

**Recreation Commission:** Mr. McCullough was not present. Mr. Albanese did state that the St. Patrick's Day Parade will be on March 21st and the 5K run.

**Roads:** Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy in February, working on the equipment, fixing signs, repairs to the red light and a lot of salting and snow removal.
