

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
March 10, 2014**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the minutes the Regular Meeting of February 10, 2014. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for February, 2014 with a total of calls was given to the supervisors. He reported that nothing is going on.

Fire Department: No one was present. It was reported the Fire Department had 4 calls last month. There were two in Daugherty Township and two in Pulaski Township. They sheltered one family at the Fire Department for three hours last week.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Ms. Dawn L. Pella was not present. Her report will be put on file.

Recreation Commission: Mrs. Kruse was not in attendance.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been very busy salting the roads and plowing snow, patching pot holes, cleaning snow from catch basins, fixing the red light and cleaning equipment.

OLD BUSINESS

Attorney Budicak stated he gave Jim Hovancik until March 31, 2014 to demolish his home on 41st Street. Also, the litigation is still going on with the suit over the dump truck.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to change the address of John and Deborah Brewer (74-001-1608-00)r from 3604 – 52nd Street to 3703 – 52nd Street, New Brighton on the recommendation of the 911 Center. (Even number houses would officially be in Rochester Township. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mr. & Mrs. Allison were present about the notice put on the doors of the Marion Hill School apartments. There was a miscommunication about the responsibility of who was to call for a re-inspection of the apartments. George Hage and Doug Margetic went there at 5:30 P. M. today and all the things that they know seemed to be taken care of. Attorney Budicak said that it was a temporary rescinded until a new inspection by Mr. Hucko. As long as the supervisors are in agreement and that they are satisfied with the corrections then they will have the secretary call Mr. Hucko and make arrangements to re-inspect the apartments and make sure that the corrections were down according to code. There are eleven apartments occupied.

Mr. Jim McCullough contacted the assessment office at the Court House about the Douglas Property. He was told to clean up the lace on 32nd Avenue and it would cost between \$3,000 or \$4,500 to demolish the house. Attorney Budicak said he would contact Mike Kohlman at the Assessment Office tomorrow and get back with Mr. McCullough.

Mrs. Massie inquired about the demolition of the Krause property. The secretary informed her that she talked to the Community Development and that the house is under contract to be demolished, but, they didn't know when it would be done. She also questioned about the house located at 3423 – 43rd Street. The Secretary will check tomorrow to find out who owns the property.

Mrs. Margetic was registering a complaint about the cars parked on 39th Avenue. One is on the road and is jacked up and no tire. There are kids in the area and someone could get hurt. It is also dangerous trying to get around the vehicles parked on the street. Chief VanFossan said he would check into the matter.
