Mrs. Griffith, the Code Enforcement Officer, stated that the people have been sent letters and have been cited. They continue to do the same and the same procedure is followed every time.

Roads: Mike Zachodni was busy in February with cleaning equipment, fixing sign on 39th Avenue, cleaning catch basins on 41st Avenue, 41st Street and 39th Avenue; fix basin on 34th

Avenue, call out for a tree down on Sunflower Road and cleaning up the debris from the storm and plowing and salting the roads.
