**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Police:** Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for February with a total of 43 calls was turned in to the supervisors. He had nothing bad to report. Mr. McCullough asked if something could be done about the speeding on 45<sup>th</sup> and 46<sup>th</sup> Street. No one is stopping for stop signs. Mr. Margetic asked about the speeding on Rochester Road. He wanted to know if the police was going to do a speed trap.

**Fire Department:** Scott Roeder, Fire Chief gave the Chairman a report that there were seven fire calls. Four were in Pulaski, one Daugherty Township and one at Big Knob.

**Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer:** Mr. John Clay, Code Enforcement Officer, was present. He reported that he had 13 calls on code enforcements and nothing on zoning. Most of his calls were about 496 Blockhouse Run. It is all cleaned up now.

**Recreation Commission:** Mrs. Kruse was in attendance. She reported that the Recreation Commission meeting was cancelled. Not enough people were in attendance.

**Roads:** Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy with snow removal, working on the equipment, hauling milling, mixing materials, fixing the sink hole at 46<sup>th</sup> Street and Rochester Road and fixing signs on 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
