

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
April 8, 2019**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Police Chief Walton, Alan Hickey, Peggy Griffith, David and Beverly Richards, Shawn Wingrove of Lennon, Smith, Souleret Engineering and Attorney Joseph M. Budicak.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to approve the minutes of the March 11, 2019 regular meeting. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruse, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay the bills. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni yes and Mrs. Kruse, yes. The motion was carried.

Before the meeting was in progress Mr. Hage gave the floor to Mr. Wingrove to give his presentation to the supervisors about the MS4 project and paving for 2019. Mr. Wingrove explained the different types of steps the supervisors could take to meet the standards for the MS4 project and showed them a map to explain everything. Also, he stated that he had contact with Widmer Engineering (New Brighton Borough's engineer) in reference to our piggy backing with the borough for paving this year. Youngblood, the paver, that was awarded the bid plans to do the paving in June.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Beverly Richards was present and brought to the attention of the supervisors the condition of the road on 47th Street. She questioned Mr. Hickey about the fire on 47th Street and why the firemen didn't do anything. Mr. Hickey informed her that they did what they are trained to do and they covered the back side of the fire.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Walton was present. A report for March, 2019 was given to the supervisors with 58 calls. Chief Walton had nothing else to report.

Fire Department: Alan Hickey, Fire Chief, was present and he reported two fire calls in Pulaski Township and five in Daugherty Township for March, 2019. The report will be put on file.

Code Enforcement and Zoning Officer: Mrs. Griffith was present. Mrs. Griffith informed the supervisors that Cindy Adams is living in the condemned trailer on 47th Street. She is going to contact her son to see if he won't find a place for her to move. Her report will be put on file.

Recreation: Mr. Cracker was not present. A copy of their April, 2019 meeting minutes will be put on file.

Roads: Mike Zachodni was busy in March with cleaning equipment, fixing sign on 39th Avenue, cleaning catch basins on 41st Avenue, 41st Street and 39th Avenue; fix basin on Cemetery Lane, 34th Avenue and 39th Street, litter patrol on 30th Street, 33rd Avenue, 42nd and 43rd Streets, patch pot holes, pick up branches and plowing and salting the roads.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to accept the Committee Reports. The vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruike, yes. The motion was carried.

OLD BUSINESS

There was no old business.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to accept the recommendation of the Planning Commission to grant a sub-division for Donald Beegle between 49th Street to 51st Street (Parcel #74-001-708-000-1 and 74-001-704-000-1). Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruike, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to piggyback with New Brighton Borough for paving for 2019. Cost to the Township will be \$38,000.12. Roads to be paved are: N 32nd Avenue (Curb), Alley, N. 31st Avenue, Engle Avenue, N 30th Avenue, 33rd Street, 34th Street and Brandon Street. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruike, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to proceed with DEP Permit application that Lennon, Smith and Souleret Engineering has prepared. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruike, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Casey Zachodni to accept the bid of Jack Senior for replacing three catch basins on New England Hill. The township is to provide the catch basins and materials needed to complete the job. Bids received were Don Beegle Inc. \$2,800, Patrick R. Carcaise Construction \$4,200 and Jack Senior Excavating \$2,889. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Zachodni, yes and Mrs. Kruike, yes. The motion was carried.
