

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
April 9, 2012**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Jim McCullough, Tina Kruse, George Doyle, Norman Bible, Donn Sheets, Debbie and Ray Hickman, Scott Roeder, Dawna Pella and Chief Van Fossan. Attorney Budicak was not present for the meeting.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the minutes of the February 13, 2012 Hearing for John Liberty and Albert Hovancik and March 12, 2012 regular meeting. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay the bills. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

Ms. Dawn L. Pella, representing D.L. Pella Consulting of Code and Zoning Enforcement Services was present to explain what they do as zoning and code enforcement officers. The hours and services will be determined by the Supervisors. She will patrol the township, warn people about the conditions of their property, give them so much time to correct the situation, after the second time they will then be cited. She does work for Chippewa Township, Bridgewater, White Township, Big Beaver, Patterson Heights and White Township to name a few. Rental registration is very important. She would like to look over our ordinances, etc. and see what has to be done.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for March with a total of 63 calls was turned in to the supervisors. He had nothing to report and no one had questions for him.

Fire Department: Scott Roeder, Fire Chief gave the Chairman a report that there were three fire calls in Pulaski and two in Daugherty Township.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: No code enforcement officer.

Recreation Commission: Mrs. Kruse was in attendance. She turned in her report for the month. The playgrounds will be opening soon and the YMCA will be furnishing the lunches this year. The playground in Pulaski Homes will be open on Monday and Wednesday from 11-2 and will run for five weeks. Cost for Monday and Wednesday which includes lunch will be \$4,050. Other programs that will be coming up is a Rivers Casino Trip on April 13, 2012, PNC Night (also T-shirt night) will be June 22, 2012 and the Gateway Clipper Summer Theme Trip on July 27th.

A Car Cruise and a 5K race will be held on September 15th. The Recreation Commission needs twenty volunteers for Saturday, May 26th for the 2012 Triathlon. Anyone interested please volunteer to help make this a success.

The New Brighton Youth Baseball Association has relinquished their lease on the Grove Avenue Youth Baseball Field. The School District is assigning the care, scheduling and maintenance of the field to the New Brighton Recreation Commission. A six months notification must be given to the Recreation Commission if the School District needs the field for some other purpose.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy with debris cleanup after the last storm, working on the equipment, hauling milling, mixing materials, fixing signs, picking up branches and cutting grass.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Bryon Mooney to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

OLD BUSINESS

There was no old business to be conducted.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Byron Mooney to exonerate Judy K. Hage, Tax Collector, from the collection of 2011 Real Estate and Per Capita Taxes. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, abstain and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Byron Mooney to turn the delinquent Per Capita Taxes over to Central Tax for collection. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes, Mr. Hage, abstain and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to hire Dawna .L. Pella Consulting as the Code Enforcement Officer for Pulaski Township. Her rate is \$15.00 per hour (not to exceed fifteen hours per month unless authorized by the supervisors) plus mileage. She will do whatever the supervisors want when it comes to patrolling, and her procedures. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, no. The motion was carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATON

Mrs. Debbie Hickman asked about the clean up for this year. Mr. Hage said there will be no cleanup this year. Money is tight and we need some roads done this year.

Also, she inquired as to what is going to be done about the guard rails on the hill going down to New Brighton. Penn Dot has been informed about it. She was advised to call Penn Dot herself and there might be a better response.

Mrs. Hickman asked if the Triathlon for the County was going to be held this year. There was not enough interest in it last year. Nothing has been said about it this year.
