

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
May 11, 2015**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting of April 13, 2015. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for April, 2015 with a total of 48 calls was given to the supervisors. He had nothing new to report.

Fire Department: Alan Hickey turned in a report that there were seven fire calls in April. There was two in Pulaski and five in Daugherty Township. The report will be put on file.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Mr. Thomas Albanese was present and his report for April will be put on file. Mr. Greathouse asked Mr. Albanese to check into the grass at the trailers on 45th and 34th Avenue. It is 8 to 10 inches high. He also questioned how two families can live in a single trailer. Mr. Albanese said that since it has been like that for so long it is impossible to do anything about it. Mr. Everly asked about the grass at the corner of 33rd Avenue and 45th Street.

Recreation Commission: No one represented.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy in April, working on the equipment, fixing signs, patching pot holes, litter patrol, checking and cleaning catch basins, remove salt from the machinery and the plow from the truck, putting up new stop signs and speed limit signs, putting gravel on 38th Street. The report will be put on file.

Mrs. Everly said there is a bad pot hole on the corner at 3928 – 37th Street and she inquired as to what hours Mike Zachodni works and if he is given a schedule for every day. Mike is working 7 to 3 daily and yes, he gets a schedule of jobs he is to do.

Don Beegle wants work in the Township. Mr. Everly said the water misses the catch basins between Marbulls and Marion Hill Grill. Mrs. Johnson is complaining about the catch basin at the corner of 38th Avenue and 46th Street again.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Attorney Budicak informed the supervisors that the papers were sent to the insurance company. He is hoping to get the case settled soon.

Mr. Hage inquired about the liens filed in the Court House. If there is an expiration date that they need to be renewed and Attorney Budicak is to check and see what liens are filed and when they are filed.

Mr. Mooney asked about the tow tag on a car on New England Hill. The tag has been there for a month and he wanted to know why it wasn't towed. Mr. Albanese said that he will check, but the owner probably put a current license plate on it and that is why it wasn't towed.

The question of who is responsible for the property in front of a residence. It was stated that the property owner is responsible for the property to the road. The township does not own any property. The township only has a right-of-way on each side of the roads so that they can maintain the roads without going on private property.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to accept the letter of resignation from James M. McCullough as representative to the New Brighton Area Recreation Commission effective April 30, 2015. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to accept the additional cost of \$4,181.10 for the Beaver County Community Development Bid for new street signs. All the street signs will be updated and meet the state requirements. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to adopt Ordinance #247 - FEMA Flood Plain Ordinance. Vote on the motion: Mr. Hage, yes; Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Mr. Thomas asked Mr. Albanese about the property at the corner of 33rd Avenue and 46th Street. They are hanging their laundry on the front porch. He asked if the Township heard anything from Penn-Dot about the situation on Sunflower Road leading down to New Brighton.

Mrs. Hickman asked if she could have her old street sign. She also stated that the Memorial Day Triathlon will be held on May 23 and they are in need of Volunteers.

Terry Johnson said the pot holes need to be patched.

Vicky Scott said that since the last meeting it has been unbelievably quiet. The other problem she has now is all the cats. There is no law or no license for cats. The township cannot do anything about cats. They are a problem all over the township.

Mrs. Massie wants something done on the bend on 41st Street before it gives way and ends up in her yard. A curb needs to be installed so the water will run off on the opposite side of the road.
