COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mr. Richards said that at 4601 Rochester Road a dog barked for six hours. He did not call the police or the Humane Society.

Mr. Paglisotti registered a complaint about the riding of dirt bikes and quads at two and three o'clock in the morning on 41st Avenue. Can't something be done? A person can't even sleep.

Mr. Beaver stated that water running down from Marbulls' and in front of the garage on 50th Street are washing out his yard. He talked to someone and they said that the township could get a grant to fix that problem. He wants a storm sewer run down to the Pulaski Homes. The supervisors will go over and check the situation out again.

Mrs. Massie said the drain from 40th Street down is 18" and runs into a 12" pipe. Mr. Margetic said they aren't finished with that project yet. She wanted to know when they will be paving. There is no date yet. Also, she asked if the Fire Department could burn off brush in the front of her property if she would give them a donation.
