

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
SPECIAL MEETING**

JUNE 5, 2013

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Doug Margetic at 5:00 P. M. in the Municipal Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag. Those in attendance were: Mr. Tom Zeglin, Mrs. Ina Weber, Mrs. JoAnne Lawrence and Attorney Budicak,

The purpose of the meeting is to consider adopting an Ordinance for the change of certain street numbers and names within the Township and any other business that may come before the Board.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by Bryon Mooney to adopt Ordinance #242 providing for the assignments of building, numbers and the public designation of privately maintained streets and roads. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to adopt Resolution #366 providing for the scheduling of residential rental property inspections. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Doug Margetic to adopt Resolution #367 urging the General Assembly to free our taxpayers from the undue fiscal burden placed on them by the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act of 1961. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

Mrs. Lawrence was requesting the supervisors to sign off on a repository for Parcel #74-001-0154-000. The supervisors agreed that the Secretary could sign off on the agreement. Mr. Doug Margetic made a motion to sign the papers and Mr. George Hage seconded the motion. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

Mrs. Weber inquired as to the whereabouts of the roadman. She never sees him. He has been busy cutting grass. She asked if something can be done about the Douglas Property on 32nd Avenue. It is in deplorable condition. The Code Enforcement Officer is checking into the situation.

There being no further business, Doug Margetic made a motion to adjourn and George Hage seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 5:24 P. M.
