

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Police:** Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for May, 2014 with a total of 56 calls was given to the supervisors. He reported that nothing is going on. Mr. Thomas asked about the unlicensed vehicles between 46<sup>th</sup> Street and 47<sup>th</sup> Street and 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. Mr. Albanese said that he has been working on that matter.

**Fire Department:** Alan Hickey was present. It was reported the Fire Department had six calls last month. There were five in Daugherty Township, and one in Pulaski Township. Mr. Margetic asked Mr. Hickey for a roster of the fireman again.

**Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer:** Ms. Dawn L. Pella was not present. She did not submit a report.

Mr. Albanese was present and his report for May will be put on file. Mr. Albanese answered questions of the citizens present. He stated that the grading on Mr. James Hovancik's property is finished. He contracted out to have grass cut at 3213 – 46<sup>th</sup> Street.
