

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR MEETING  
June 11, 2018**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. George Hage. Mr. Hage led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Peggy Griffith, Terry Johnson, Don Chapman, Betty Winner, Harry Girting, Gerald Giansanti, Chief Walton and Attorney Joseph M. Budicak.

A motion was made by Kimberly Keener Johnson and seconded by Casey Zachodni to approve the minutes of May 14, 2018 Work Session and Regular Meeting. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Hage, yes; Mrs. Johnson, yes and Mr. Zachodni, yes. The motion was carried.

They are supposed to be on a leash. Also, she wanted to know when the house on 41<sup>st</sup> Street is to be demolished and how. The County will do that. Also, she was wondering about the sewer systems and how it would affect the citizens.

Harry Girting of 3208 – 44<sup>th</sup> Street about the letter he received from the Code Enforcement Officer and wants to know where in the township maintenance it states that you can't store things in black garbage bags. As for the brush pile in the back yard – it has been there for over thirty years and the other pile is a compost pile. He will have the weeds trimmed.

Mrs. Griffith explained she has to follow procedure when mailing letters. Mr. Girting felt the letter was threatening. The three supervisors assured him that she is following procedures and is doing a very good job for the township.

Mr. Girting complained about the structure fire on 45<sup>th</sup> Street and the fact that the hoses were taken in the front door. Also, no one should be entering the fire area when there is a fire - only firemen.

Mr. Giansanti of 3313 N. 30<sup>th</sup> Avenue wanted to know what can be done about parking vehicles on the street and blocking his driveway. Chief Walton told him that he will send a certified letter to the owner about the parking. He also stated that the ordinance may need to be revised in reference to 30<sup>th</sup> Avenue parking.
