

PULASKI TOWNSHIP
WORK SESSION
July 13, 2020

The work session meeting was called to order at 5:27 pm by Mark Wagle. Those in attendance were Ralph Flara, Mark Wagle and Casey Zachodni.

- Road Paving- Casey talked with a few different places regarding the estimate for the paving this year and stated it will be around \$50,000 - \$60,000, which is a bit high. Casey spoke with Youngblood and got a bid of \$90/ton, it could cost \$45,000 - \$60,000 for the whole 45th street top to bottom. Going to do a bid for 45th Street and 3 alternate roads.
- Bids will be taken by engineers for roads and will be due in the office by 8-6-2020 by 2pm
- The basin on 31st Avenue will need a new catch basin sometime next year.
- Adam & Markita Adams have purchased parcel # 74-001-0435 and are asking that the taxes for 2016-2018 be exonerated. The school board allowed the taxes to be exonerated for 2016-2018. When I spoke with Mr. Adams, he said he would be at the regular meeting to explain to the board.
- The indefinite closing of Cemetery Bridge is scheduled for July 31, 2020. We need to get jersey barriers and signs to do so. Ralph mentioned to ask Daugherty if they might have any they are not using.
- Duquesne Light has sent us the information to proceed with replacing 10 more streetlights in the township to LED lights. We need to decide which 10, all 10 need to be in consecutive order. Decision and paperwork need to be in by September 1, 2020.
- Peggy is busy keeping up with zoning permits for pools/decks in the township.
- Casey announced we need to be careful as to how many phone calls we make to Attorney Budicak and to the Engineers to avoid any unnecessary charges. Any decisions need to be made with all supervisors having knowledge of any calls made dealing with township business.
- Ralph does not agree with comp time. When the police call Mike out they would have a record of those time.
