A motion was made by Mr. Wagle and seconded by Mr. Zachodni to table the decision on the bids for the roads until all the information is read. A special meeting will be scheduled later. Vote on the motion: Mr. Wagle – yes, Mr. Zachodni – yes, Mr. Flara – yes. The motion is carried.
