

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Fire Department: Alan Hickey was present. It was reported the Fire Department had 7 calls last month. There was four in Daugherty Township, and three in Pulaski Township.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer:

Mr. Thomas Albanese was present and his report for July will be put on file.

Recreation Commission: James McCullough was present. He reported some activities for the Recreation Commission they have planned for next year. He gave us a report to put on file.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy patching pot holes, planting grass on 34th Avenue, working at the garage and cleaning trucks, cleaning catch basins on 34th Avenue and 42nd Avenue, cutting grass, weed whacking and picking up branches. OLD BUSINESS

Attorney Budicak is hoping to have a settlement for the 2010 truck by the next meeting. Also, he filing a Municipal Claim for the demolition, code enforcement and legal expenses for the property of Mr. and Mrs. James Hovancik property located on 41st Street.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Terry Johnson was present about the problems at the corner of 38th Avenue and 46th Street. Mr. Margetic said that the road will be paved this year and as for the corner, the township will try to fix the problem, but, at the present time no one can come up with a solution to the problem.

Don Moore was present and asked why the Township is tar and chipping instead of paving. Paving would be better and do a couple of roads that will last instead of five or six that won't last. Mr. Margetic said we are piggy backing with New Brighton and hoping they will start soon and they are going to scratch coat and then tar and chip.

Bill Thomas thanked Mr. Mooney for talking to the property owner of the animal house because things have calmed down a lot and Mrs. Vicky Scott did the same.

Debbie Hickman inquired about the pot holes on 34th Avenue and Sunflower Road. Also, about the high grass at the Fire Department and seeing the secretary sweeping up and didn't feel that should be her job. The Secretary said volunteers came in and cut and weed whacked this last time and they did a fine job.

Mr. Moore asked about the merging of Pulaski Township and Daugherty Township Fire Departments. Mr. Hage stated that a meeting is scheduled between the two fire departments and the supervisors of both townships to discuss the matter. He also asked about the lot the township owns on Sunflower Road that everyone is using for a parking lot. He wanted to know if we are insured and what we intend to do with the property. The township does have insurance and they don't have the money to construct a new building. The Attorney and the secretary are to see if they have a copy of the survey for that property.

Mr. McCullough told the supervisors and Mr. Albanese that Unis Demolition is to come in and demolish the house on 32nd Avenue tomorrow. Unis already has the Zoning permit.
