

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 6:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for July with a total of 42 calls was given to the supervisors. He reported that the police will be patrolling Rochester Road and 43rd Street in the township.

Fire Department: Alan Hickey was present for the Fire Department. He reported that there were fifteen fires: eleven in Pulaski Township and four in Daugherty.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Ms. Dawn L. Pella was not present. She turned in her report for June, 2013 and for July, 2013 and it will be put in her file.

Recreation Commission: Mrs. Kruse was not in attendance. She turned in her monthly report and it will be put in the files.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy with cutting grass and weed whacking, cleaning catch basins, worked at Cemetery Lane, fixed signs and the grate on 41st Street and picked up branches from the storm.

A motion was made by George Hage and seconded by Byron Mooney to accept the Committee Reports. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Margetic announced that letters were mailed out to the all residents that have to change their addresses. The process with the 911 Center, Medic Rescue, Fire Department, Police Department, Engineer and the Supervisors is now complete. Everyone has one year to put the change in place.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to have a public meeting with the Code Enforcement Officer and Attorney Budicak on August 28, 2013 at 6:30 P. M. in the municipal building. It will be a Special Meeting and it will be advertised. Vote on the motion: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

Donn Sheets was told about the township planing to file a civil suit in reference to the property owners who problems and not keeping their properties up to the codes.

Attorney Budicak brought up the problem of an abandoned mobile home in Willow Tree Estates and he explained the situation to the Supervisors. After checking with the County, he stated that the owner of the property, Gale Helbling, could have the home demolish and disposed of without any problem. The supervisors gave him permission to contact Mr. Helbling and tell him the procedure he needs to follow.

He also had information on the Harold Ehrenberg Estate and he told Mr. Ehrenberg's heirs attorney to contact Mr. Helbling if they want to appeal the zoning.

Gary Krause said that he will be at the Special Meeting on August 28, 2013 in reference to the Code Enforcement Officer citing him for stuff on his property that doesn't belong to him, but one of his tenants.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATON

Mrs. Barbara Blinn was present to ask about the vacating of the roads in Pulaski Township. She went to the Court House and the vacation of the roads was never recorded in the Court House. Attorney Budicak said that he will record them before the August 28th meeting. She also said that the road by her property is washing away. Mr. Margetic told her that he will check into the matter and see what can be done.
