COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for July with a total of 62 calls was turned in to the supervisors. Mr. Donn Sheets asked about the pit bulls on 39th Street and he reported about the children up there going all over the place on other people's property. One of them jumped out the hedges right in front of him. Someone is going to get hurt seriously and no one seems to care. April McCombs is passing a petition to get rid of the pit bulls.

Fire Department: Scott Roeder, Fire Chief was present. He reported that there was one fire call in Pulaski and five fire calls in Daugherty in June. In July there were seven calls. Fire hydrants have been spot checked. In case of a fire there are four tanker trucks that come to the township.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Ms. Dawn L. Pella was not present. She turned in her report and it will be put on file.

Recreation Commission: Mrs. Kruse was in attendance. She reported that the Recreation Commission discussed the new baseball field. They are having some problems with the watering system not having enough pressure and the grass is dying. That is being worked on now.

Roads: Mr. Margetic reported that Mike has been busy with cutting grass, weed whacking, installing a catch basin on 41st street and fixing one on 45th Street, sprayed for bees

and picking up branches. Also, all the catch basins will be cleaned out as soon as the Borough gets their truck back. Hopefully it will be done by the end of the month.

Mr. Doyle questioned about the Rental Property Ordinance and Mr. Margetic explained it to him.
