

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING
September 14, 2020**

The Pulaski Townships Supervisors meeting was called to order on Monday, September 14, 2020 @ 6:30 PM in the Pulaski Township Fire Hall, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, Pa. Mr. Mark Wagle, chairman led the pledge to the flag.

Those in attendance were: Mark Wagle, Casey Zachodni, Ralph Flara, Elaine Hildebrand, Debbie Hickman, Attorney Joseph A. Budicak, Peggy Griffith, Officer Ron Walton, Officer Hall and Connie Wagle.

A motion was made by Mr. Wagle and seconded by Mr. Zachodni to approve the minutes of the August meeting. Vote on the motion: Mr. Wagle – yes, Mr. Zachodni – yes, Mr. Flara – yes. The motion is carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Zachodni and seconded by Mr. Flara to accept the Treasurers report and pay the bills. Vote on the motion: Mr. Wagle – yes, Mr. Zachodni – yes, Mr. Flara – yes. The motion is carried.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Elaine Hildebrand is still concerned about the water runoff in front of her home due to natural spring, she would like something done to stop it or prevent it. Mr. Zachodni assured her it would be taken care of but top of the list is paving now. He also said the Road Foreman will need help with the job and possibly we could get someone from Daugherty or New Brighton to help. Debbie Hickman had nothing for tonight's meeting.

CORRESPONDENCE

We received information in the mail regarding the Concrete Jungle Basketball, an organization being formed for high school aged children as well as any graduates from 2020. We also received information from New Brighton Basketball Boosters asking to place an ad in their 2020/2021 program. Mr. Bill Thomas turned in his resignation letter resigning from the zoning board due to personal reasons. There is also a concern about cars speeding and not stopping at the stop signs.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Officer Hall presented the police report for August 2020. The report will be placed on file in the office. Mr. Zachodni mentioned about speeding cars and cars running stop signs as well.

Fire Department: There was no one present at the meeting to give report.

Code Enforcement/Zoning Officer: Peggy Griffith was present to give the report. She stated work on the old gas station is delayed due to Covid -19 there is no lumber available and they cannot get the trusses either. She had the hearing with Jessica Eisenhour, regarding the clean up around the house at 3405 47th Street, she sees no action yet, however. She will check with Sam Botinovich regarding the cars in the front, he would park cars there to prevent people from dumping garbage off.

OLD BUSINESS

The 2020 DUQUESNE LIGHT LED STREET LIGHT PROGRAM will be delayed until 2021 due to the back log of work from Covid-19 in March. We have not heard from the Engineers as to when the paving will start, Mr. Zachodni mentioned hopefully October/November it will be done.

A motion was made by Mr. Zachodni and seconded by Mr. Flara to renew the contract with Penn Dot for snow plowing for 2020/2021 season to plow Blockhouse Run Road, Sunflower Road, Virginia Avenue/Rochester Road. Vote: Mr. Wagle – yes, Mr. Zachodni – yes, Mr. Flara – yes. The motion is carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Wagle and seconded by Mr. Zachodni to use MGSoft-NET, Inc. for any IT issues with computer problems in the future. Vote on the motion: Mr. Wagle – yes, Mr. Zachodni – yes, Mr. Flara – yes. The motion is carried.

A question was brought up by Attorney Budicak regarding Adam Beaver as to whether he paid the back taxes of \$4,000,00 so that he can file the records and clear it with the courthouse. Connie Wagle will reach out to him to check on the status of this.

WORK SESSION
September 14, 2020**

The work session was called to order @ 5:30 pm in the Pulaski Township Fire Hall.

Those present were: Mark Wagle, Casey Zachodni, Ralph Flara, Connie Wagle

The topics of discussions were as follows:

- Renewal of the snowplow contract needs renewed with Penn Dot – contracts are good for 5 years before needing renewed.
- 2020 Duquesne Light LED STREET LIGHT REPLACEMENT PROGRAM – has been delayed until 2021 due to being back logged for 3 months due to Covid-19.
- Discussed using MGSoft-Net, Inc. in Beaver for any computer problems that may arrive to avoid the problems we faced in the past. They will network the desk PC and laptop as well using Splashtop Business. Fee is \$90/hour.
- We are not exactly sure on date the paving will start in the township. The engineer is working on the paperwork.
- With regrets we received the resignation of Mr. Bill Thomas from the zoning board effectively immediately.
- Trick -r-Treat, Daugherty, New Brighton, Fallston have set their trick r treat time to Thursday, October 29, 2020 @ 6:00 – 7:30 PM.
- The Halloween Parade in New Brighton is cancelled this year.
- Basketball Boosters are asking us to place an add in their program for 2020-2021 season.
- Mr. Flara stated the inspection for Cemetery Bridge still needs to occur, inspection is required for all bridges, opened or closed. Inspections are to occur every 24 months. Mr. Flara has started some paperwork in hopes to repair or replace bridge someday.
- It was discussed to add an additional work session to next year having a work session in February, May, July and September, only using September work session if needed. The supervisors all agreed to have the meeting for opening the books in 2021 on Monday, January 4, 2021, with the first regular meeting on January 11, 2021.

The work session was adjourned at 6:00 PM.
