

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to accept the minutes of the Regular Meeting of September 10, 2012. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Margetic, yes; Mr. Hage, yes and Mr. Mooney, yes. The motion was carried.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Police: Chief Charles VanFossan was present. A report for September with a total of 48 calls was turned in to the supervisors. He had nothing to report.

All debris will be removed from the site and all wood will be cut and left on the site. Other bids were from Four Seasons Lawn Service, New Brighton in the amount of \$2,400.00 and Graham's Tree Service, New Brighton in the amount of \$2,900.00.
