

**PULASKI TOWNSHIP
EMERGENCY SPECIAL MEETING
November 10, 2010
7:30 P. M.**

The Pulaski Township Supervisors meeting was called to order at 7:30 P. M. in the Township Building, 3401 Sunflower Road, New Brighton, PA by the Chairman of the Board, Mr. Doug Margetic. Mr. Margetic led the Pledge to the Flag.

In attendance were the following people: Mr. Margetic, Mr. Hage, Mrs. Margetic, and Mr. Paul Henn.

The emergency meeting was called because of a rat situation at the Carlton Adams property located at 3300 – 47th Street, New Brighton, PA 15066. The house is infested with over a thousand rats and they now are moving outside. Mr. Clay, the Code enforcement Officer, has called in Bryson Exterminating and they have already put poison out to kill the rats. Mr. Clay inspected the premises and it is deplorable. Mr. Bryson said it would take five days to kill the rats before they can start any demolition of the property.

Quotes were received from the following:

Joe DeMuzio Developers, LLC	\$18,200 House and Garage
Unis Demolition Company	\$ 7,400 House and \$3,000 for the Garage
Tom Sipes Demolition	\$ 5,000 House and with Garage \$6,500

A motion was made by Doug Margetic and seconded by George Hage to accept the bid from Tom Sipes Demolition in the amount of \$5,000 for the house and \$6,500 for the house and the garage. The garage will not be demolished if it is determined by the Exterminator that there are no rats in the garage. Vote on the motion was: Mr. Margetic, yes and Mr. Hage, yes. Mr. Mooney was absent. The motion was carried.

Demolition will proceed at 7:30 A. M. on Friday November 12, 2010 if it is determined that it is safe and the rats are dead.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:35 P. M. Mr. Mooney came at 7:42 P. M.
